HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE SCHOOL OF TRAVEL INDUSTRY MANAGEMENT AT THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT MANOA TO DEVELOP ENHANCEMENTS FOR THE TOURISM-RELATED CAPABILITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII ECONOMIC RESEARCH ORGANIZATION DATA PORTAL.

WHEREAS, tourism continues to be one of the largest and 1 most significant sectors of Hawaii's economy; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the travel industry, a vital component of the 4 tourism sector, is highly price-sensitive and subject to both 5 domestic and international economic performance; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the sometimes volatile nature of the travel 8 industry and tourism as a whole requires that professionals in 9 these industries have a clear understanding of market data and 10 trends and how to use such data and trends in short- and long-11 term business planning and management; and 12 13 WHEREAS, the School of Travel Industry Management at the 14 University of Hawaii at Manoa has an international reputation of 15 producing hospitality, tourism, and travel management 16 professionals equipped to take on the challenges of Hawaii's 17 tourism sector; and 18 19 WHEREAS, the knowledge and expertise of faculty within the 20 School of Travel Industry Management means that the School is 21 ideally suited to provide additional market analysis tools to 22 assist industry professionals in making business decisions; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the University of Hawaii Economic Research 25 Organization Data Portal's menu-driven interface and wide array 26 of economic and social indicators represents an ideal platform 27 for travel industry professionals to access relevant data to aid 28 in such short- and long-term business planning and decision-29 making; now, therefore, 30

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 1 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 2 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the School of Travel 3 Industry Management at the University of Hawaii at Manoa is 4 requested to develop enhancements for the tourism-related 5 capabilities of the University of Hawaii Economic Research 6 Organization Data Portal; and 7 8 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these enhancements include: 9 10 A broad cross-section of relevant variables, including (1) 11 visitor origin data based on established major 12 markets, to provide a complete picture of the various 13 aspects of the travel industry; 14 15 The development of additional analytical capabilities (2) 16 for tourism-related data; 17 18 Additional graphical display options for available (3) 19 data analyses; 20 21 The capability to display visitor data trends at both (4) 22 the State and county levels; 23 24 The presentation of micro-level trends; and (5) 25 26 The inclusion of data on visitor attendance at major (6) 27 attractions, including National Park sites; 28 29 30 and 31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the School of Travel Industry 32 Management develop an online tutorial and provide regular in-33 person training seminars to visitor industry professionals on 34 how to use the Data Portal to assist in decision-making; and 35 36 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the School of Travel Industry 37 Management submit a report on the progress of this project to 38 the Legislature no later than 20 days prior to the convening of 39 the 2012 Regular Session; and 40

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Dean of the School of Travel Industry Management and Executive Director of the Economic Research Organization of the University of Hawaii.
