HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE CITY AND COUNTY OF HONOLULU TO PROVIDE IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY FOR NEIGHBORHOOD BOARD MEMBERS ACTING IN THEIR OFFICIAL CAPACITY OR TO ENSURE THAT NEIGHBORHOOD BOARD MEMBERS WILL BE DEFENDED.

WHEREAS, neighborhood boards are volunteer organizations 1 whose members serve without compensation; and 2 3 WHEREAS, neighborhood board members are duly elected 4 representatives of their communities; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the mission of neighborhood boards is to voice the 7 concerns of their communities; and 8 9 WHEREAS, neighborhood boards have been threatened with 10 lawsuits seeking to reverse board decisions; and 11 12 WHEREAS, neighborhood boards do not have the funds to 13 defend themselves in court, nor have they been defended by the 14 City and County of Honolulu Corporation Counsel; and 15 16 WHEREAS, serving as voices for their respective 17 communities, neighborhood boards should remain free to lend a 18 voice to issues of importance without being silenced by the 19 threat of a lawsuit; now, therefore, 20 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 22 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 23 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the City and County of 24 Honolulu is urged to provide immunity from liability for 25 neighborhood board members acting in their official capacity or 26 to ensure that neighborhood board members will be adequately 27 defended; and 28
