HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE GOVERNOR TO ESTABLISH A SISTER-STATE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN HAWAII AND THE PROVINCE OF LIMA, PERU.

WHEREAS, Hawaii maintains a heritage of international 1 participation and cultural sensitivity unparalleled in other 2 states due to its multicultural population since the reign of 3 the Hawaiian monarchy in the early 19th century; and 4 5 WHEREAS, since 1981, the Legislature has instituted sister-6 state relationships as a means of asserting its active 7 participation in international matters; and 8 9 WHEREAS, as of December 2008, Hawaii maintained 15 sister-10 state relationships, mostly between Asia and the Pacific; and 11 12 WHEREAS, it is advantageous to continue to pursue sister-13 state relationships for cultural and economic development 14 reasons, with attention focused on fostering the most productive 15 ties; and 16 17 WHEREAS, Hawaii is actively seeking to expand its 18 international ties and has an interest in developing goodwill, 19 friendship, and economic relations with Lima, Peru; and 20 21 WHEREAS, a relationship between Hawaii and Peru would be 22 mutually beneficial, advancing mutual goals for international 23 peace and brotherhood; now, therefore, 24 25 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 26 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 27 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Governor is requested 28 to establish a sister-state relationship between Hawaii and the 29 province of Lima, Peru; and 30 31



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the United States Secretary of State, Prime Minister of the province of Lima, Peru, and Governor of the State of Hawaii.
