HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE STATE OF HAWAI`I, DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND TOURISM TO OPEN UP THE PARKING LOT AT THE FOREIGN-TRADE ZONE NO. 9, FROM 8 PM TO 6 AM TO SERVE AS NIGHTTIME PARKING FOR WORKING HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS.

WHEREAS the State of Hawai`i and its residents are 1 2 suffering from a significant economic downturn; and, 3 4 WHEREAS due to the current state of the economy there is an apparent lack of availability of affordable housing in the 5 6 State; and, 7 WHEREAS the foreclosures resulting from the housing 8 collapse have further contributed to the growing population of 9 homeless among working individuals; and, 10 11 WHEREAS these individuals, while struggling to hold their 12 lives together and keep their jobs, are faced with instability 13 and the dangers of sleeping in their vehicles on the streets; 14 15 and, 16 17 WHEREAS the State has a vast inventory of parking spaces and is asked to avail their parking lots from 8 pm to 6 am for 18 the working homeless who reside in their vehicles; and, 19 20 WHEREAS this will greatly benefit the working homeless by 21 providing safety and access to services; and, 22 23 WHEREAS a myriad of other States, Cities, Churches, and 24 other organizations in the State of California, Oregon, and 25 Texas, to name a few, have already adopted this practice with 26 great success in helping these working individuals; and, 27 28 WHEREAS the Country of Kauai is now launching this program; 29 30 and,

1 WHEREAS, the Foreign-Trade Zone no. 9 parking lot, 521 Ala 2 3 Moana Boulevard, #201 is vacant between the hours of 8 p.m. and 6 a.m., is close to Downtown services and several free meal 4 5 programs, and would thus be an appropriate location for a 6 temporary homeless parking lot; now, therefore, 7 8 BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the 9 Twenty-Sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, 2011 Regular 10 Session, the Senate concurring, urge the State of Hawai`i, Department of Economic Development and Tourism to open up the 11 Foreign-Trade Zone no. 9 parking lot, 521 Ala Moana Boulevard, 12 13 #201, from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. to serve as nighttime parking for 14 working homeless individuals; 15 ; and 16 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that rulemaking authority for this 18 program should remain with the Department of Economic 19 Development and Tourism; and 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the intention of this 22 resolution is for a temporary solution, until adequate permanent 23 affordable housing solutions are found; and 24 25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the number of vehicles allowed 26 in this parking lot be determined by the participating agency; 27 and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that restrooms will be provided for 30 by the participating agency, a non-profit organization or through a grant from a private business; and 31 32 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that certified copies of this 33 34 Resolution be transmitted to the Honorable Neil Abercrombie, Governor of the State of Hawai`i, and the Director of the State 35 of Hawai`i Department of Business and Economic Development. 36 37 OFFERED BY: fide Cubanilla 38 39
