## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A FINANCIAL AND MANAGEMENT AUDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION.

WHEREAS, Hawaii's public education system has been 1 criticized for its inadequate delivery of educational services 2 and for poor student achievement; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the large bureaucracy of the Department of 6 Education presents roadblocks that could prevent the Department of Education and the individual schools from successfully 7 8 performing their duties and serving the needs of Hawaii's 9 children: and 10 WHEREAS, recently, the Department became the subject of 11 local and national news when furloughs were imposed in the 12 public schools, which reduced the number of instructional days 13 for students; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the Department's leadership was decentralized 16 through the creation of the complex area system to place a 17 greater number of decisions and more funds directly in the hands 18 of individual school administrators; and 19 20 WHEREAS, Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, was intended 21 to implement comprehensive reform in Hawaii's public schools by, 22 among other things: 23 24 25 (1)Reducing the bureaucracy that hampers the effectiveness of the Department of Education; and 26 27 28 (2) Focusing more resources and control at the individual school level; and 29 30 31 WHEREAS, today, the Department of Education remains under close public scrutiny, both locally and nationally; and 32

1 2 WHEREAS, the public has raised many guestions about the 3 Department's operations, including its finances and management; 4 and 5 6 WHEREAS, a financial and management audit of the Department 7 of Education is long overdue; and 8 9 WHEREAS, an audit of the Department would improve critical educational services provided by this large taxpayer-funded 10 institution that absorbs a large percentage of the state budget, 11 by examining in-depth the effectiveness and efficiency of 12 13 departmental operations, both at the management and 14 administrative levels, including the: 15 Organization and management of the Department of 16 (1)Education, especially with regard to personnel; and 17 18 (2) Efficacy of fiscal operations, especially with respect 19 to spending and accountability; and 20 21 WHEREAS, it is imperative that the Department remain 22 23 committed to providing quality education for all of Hawaii's children, ensuring that all staff members and resources are 24 dedicated to that mission; and 25 26 WHEREAS, an audit would ensure that the Department of 27 Education adheres to its mission to provide all of Hawaii's 28 children with the tools they need to be successful in a global 29 society; now, therefore, 30 31 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 32 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 33 34 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor is requested to 35 perform a financial and management audit of the Department of Education that focuses on the departmental level; and 36 37 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 38 submit a report of any findings and recommendations to the 39 Legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of 40 the Regular Session of 2012; and 41 42 43 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 44 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor, the HCR LRB 11-1504.doc
