HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING A SUNRISE REVIEW TO DETERMINE WHETHER EACH COUNTY SHOULD ADMINISTER A PERMIT PROGRAM FOR LARGE SCALE DOG BREEDERS.

WHEREAS, there are an estimated four thousand puppy mills 1 in the United States that breed more than a half-million puppies 2 each year; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, the large scale breeding of dogs is often conducted under conditions that inflict long-term suffering on 6 7 the dogs; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the large scale breeding of dogs may lead to the sale of unhealthy dogs to unsuspecting consumers; and 10 11 12 WHEREAS, many of the puppies for sale in pet shops are the 13 offspring of dogs maintained by large scale breeders in brutal conditions; and 14 15 16 WHEREAS, Hawaii is one of the few states where puppy mills 17 are allowed to flourish because of a lack of permitting and 18 buyer recourse; and 19 20 WHEREAS, recent news reports have identified a major puppy mill operation located in Waimanalo; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS, establishing a permit program for large scale dog breeders would help prevent cruelty to dogs and protect 24 consumers; and 25 26 WHEREAS, a permit program would provide, at minimum, for 27 28 inspection of the breeding facility to ensure adequacy and cleanliness, information regarding the number of puppies born, 29 and the payment of licensing fees; and 30 31

WHEREAS, H.B. No. 1192, introduced during the Regular 1 2 Session of 2011, requires that, in order to operate a large scale dog breeding operation, a person shall possess a valid dog 3 4 breeder permit issued by the appropriate county animal control 5 officer or agency; and 6 7 WHEREAS, under section 26H-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, 8 measures that would subject unregulated professions and 9 occupations to licensing or other regulatory controls cannot be enacted unless the Auditor has conducted a sunrise review of the 10 specific measure identified through a concurrent resolution; 11 12 now, therefore, 13 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 15 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Auditor is requested to 16 17 perform a sunrise review of the regulation of large scale dog breeders by the various counties as contemplated under H.B. No. 18 1192, introduced during the Regular Session of 2011; and 19 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Auditor is requested to 22 submit to the Legislature a report on any findings and recommendations, including proposed legislation, not later than 23 24 twenty days prior to the convening of the Regular Session of 2012; and 25 26 27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 28 Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Auditor and to the 29 mayor and the chairperson of the legislative body of each 30 county. 31 32 Conthis Thicken 33 OFFERED BY:
