HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

RECOGNIZING THE CULTURAL, EDUCATIONAL, ACADEMIC, POLITICAL, AND ECONOMIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE PEOPLE OF HAWAII AND THE REPUBLIC OF TURKEY.

WHEREAS, the Republic of Turkey and the United States of 1 2 America are long-standing allies that cherish the universal values of freedom, democracy, and human rights; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, in its alliance with the United States, the Republic of Turkey demonstrates a commitment to world peace and 6 7 liberty, as well as a tolerance of others regarding secular and 8 religious issues; and 9 10 WHEREAS, the Republic of Turkey, the world's fifteenth largest economy and Europe's sixth largest economy, is a valued 11 trading partner with the State of Hawaii, and is to be commended 12 on its contributions to the global economy; and 13 14 15 WHEREAS, in 2009, Turkish exports to the United States totaled about \$3,300,000,000, and United States exports to 16 Turkey totaled about \$8,600,000,000; and 17 18 WHEREAS, on December 7, 2009, the United States and the 19 Republic of Turkey launched a new cabinet-level initiative 20 called the Framework for Strategic Economic and Commercial 21 Cooperation to increase trade and investment relations; and 22 23 WHEREAS, the State of Hawaii and the Republic of Turkey 24 enjoy a strong, vibrant, and mutually beneficial economic 25 26 relationship, with the prospect of future growth; and 27

2 all who come to our State, especially those who come in the interest of friendship and commerce; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, on January 20, 2011, the Pacifica Institute hosted the First Annual Dialogue and Friendship Dinner to promote peace 6 7 and a better understanding of the Hawaii Turkish-American 8 community among all of Hawaii's multi-cultural population; and 9 WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the State of Hawaii 10 to further cultivate the mutually beneficial relationship 11 between the State of Hawaii and the Republic of Turkey and other 12 13 Turkic Nations; and 14 WHEREAS, it is the policy of the House of Representatives 15 to recognize the value of maintaining beneficial relationships 16 17 with our allies, and the contributions of our allies, including the contributions made by the Republic of Turkey and the value 18 of our positive relationship with this ally; now, therefore, 19 20 21 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 22 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the Legislature recognizes 23 the long standing relationship between Hawaii and the Republic 24 of Turkey, looks forward to building upon our time-honored 25 friendship, as well as promoting the cultural, educational, 26 academic, political, and economic relations between the people 27 28 of Hawaii and the Republic of Turkey; and 29 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Pacifica Institute 31 and the West America Turkic Council. 32 33 34 35 OFFERED BY: Mele Came doc FEB 0 8 2011
