HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE COMMERCIAL AIRLINE INDUSTRY TO EXTEND VARIOUS COURTESIES TO MEMBERS OF THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES WITH MILITARY ORDERS WHO ARE TRANSPORTED BY COMMERCIAL AIRCRAFT, IN RECOGNITION OF THEIR SERVICE TO THE PEOPLE OF THE UNITED STATES AND AS AN EXPRESSION OF GRATITUDE AND APPRECIATION.

1 WHEREAS, the men and women of America's Armed Forces,
2 without hesitation, stand fast against those that threaten the
3 security of our nation; and

5 WHEREAS, while the might of the United States military is 6 unprecedented, part of this power relies on the ability to 7 transport troops and supplies anywhere around the world at a 8 moment's notice; and 9

10 WHEREAS, although the United States military has a 11 remarkable transportation network, at times it makes more 12 logistical sense to use commercial aircraft to transport troops, 13 particularly if the number of those being transported is small; 14 and 15

16 WHEREAS, while it is understandable that commercial 17 airlines charge baggage fees to assist them in dealing with the 18 additional costs they are facing, particularly during the recent 19 economic downturn, applying these additional charges to troops 20 who are fighting in defense of our freedoms could be viewed as 21 inappropriate; and 22

WHEREAS, in an act of appreciation for their service to our
 country, the baggage fees currently charged by commercial
 airlines could be waived for those individuals of the Armed

Forces who are traveling on commercial aircraft under military 1 2 orders; and 3 4 WHEREAS, extending additional courtesies to these military personnel, such as first class or business upgrades, when 5 6 available, at no additional cost and eliminating charges for overweight baggage, would be an additional expression of 7 8 gratitude and deep appreciation for the sacrifices of the 9 members of the armed services; now, therefore, 10 11 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 12 13 of 2011, the Senate concurring, that the commercial airline industry is urged to extend various courtesies to members of the 14 Armed Forces traveling on military orders, including the waiving 15 16 of baggage and excess baggage weight fees and providing first class or business class upgrades when available, as an 17 expression of gratitude and appreciation for service to the 18 19 United States; and 20 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Chairman of the 22 Joint Chiefs of Staff, Hawaii's congressional delegation, Air 23 24 Transport Association of America, Inc., and Airlines Committee of Hawaii. 25 26 27 Laren Ausenan 28 OFFERED BY:
