## HOUSE RESOLUTION

URGING THE AMENDING OF THE HOUSE RULES TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE ADVANCE NOTICE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING FROM FORTY-EIGHT TO SEVENTY-TWO HOURS, EXCLUDING THE HOURS ON WEEKENDS AND REQUIRING A VOTE BY THE FULL HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES FOR THERE TO BE WAIVER IN THE HEARING NOTICE REQUIREMENT.

WHEREAS, transparency is government's obligation to share
information with citizens, and it is as the heart of how
citizens holds their public officials accountable; and

5 WHEREAS, a more transparent government begins with 6 providing the people the opportunity to tell their elected 7 officials what they think of a piece of legislation, before it 8 comes up for a vote; and

10 WHEREAS, through giving the people adequate time to review 11 and comment on proposed bills and legislation will improve the 12 quality of legislation and enhance trust in government; and

14 WHEREAS, to ensure public participation in committee 15 hearings, House Rule 11.5, subsection 1, provides that notice of 16 committee meetings or decision making must be publicly posted at 17 forty-eight hours prior to the meeting; and

19 WHEREAS, this forty-eight hour rule includes weekends and 20 holidays, and also includes a provision allowing it to be 21 shortened "at the discretion of the Speaker upon request on the 22 House floor by a chair or vice-chair and upon good cause shown"; 23 and

25 WHEREAS, the existing short notice makes it difficult for 26 ordinary citizens to write testimony and almost impossible for 27 them to rearrange their work or personal schedules to attend a 28 hearing; and

1 2 WHEREAS, more notice of a committee hearing will allow for 3 more citizens and organizations to submit more meaningful testimony and can make a big difference in getting more people 4 5 to participate in the democratic process; and 6 WHEREAS, to ensure citizens are getting adequate advance 7 notice of a hearing, the forty-eight hour rule should be 8 extended to seventy-two hours and those hours must not include 9 weekends or holidays; and 10 11 WHEREAS, in order to increase transparency, whenever an 12 13 exception to the hearing notice rule is necessary, the members of the House should vote on granting the exception to ensure 14 accountability for implementing the exception; now, therefore, 15 16 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 17 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 18 of 2011, that the House of Representatives is urged to amend the 19 rules of the House of Representatives to be amended to extend 20 the time for public notice of a committee hearing from forty-21 22 eight to seventy-two hours; and 23 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the rules of the House of 24 Representatives be amended to include a provision stipulating 25 that the new seventy-two hours notice of a hearing does not 26 include weekends or holidays; and 27 28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the rules of the House of 29 Representatives be amended to require that a waiver of the new 30 seventy-two hour hearing notice requirement can only be granted 31 upon approval of a vote by the full House of Representatives; 32 and 33 34 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this 35 Resolution be transmitted to the Speaker of the House of 36 Representatives, the House Majority Leader, the House Majority 37 Floor Leader, the House Minority Leader, and the House Minority 38 Floor Leader. 39 40 41
