BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, that the Hawaii Sister-State Committee is urged to establish opportunities to develop and foster international relationships, both official and personal, between the State of Hawaii and the international community, including:
