## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE STATE FOUNDATION ON CULTURE AND THE ARTS TO CONVENE A TASK FORCE TO EXPLORE THE CREATION OF A NEW, SUSTAINABLE SYMPHONY IN THE WAKE OF THE LIQUIDATION OF THE HONOLULU SYMPHONY.

WHEREAS, prior to filing for bankruptcy and liquidation 1 late in 2009, the Honolulu Symphony had a storied history of 2 3 producing and performing symphonic music for more than a 4 century; and 5 6 WHEREAS, the Honolulu Symphony was a nationally recognized orchestra, having recorded the soundtrack to the film "Princess 7 Kaiulani," and earning a Grammy nomination; and 8 9 10 WHEREAS, Hawaii residents, and the youth in particular, will greatly benefit from continued exposure to symphony 11 12 performances; and 13 WHEREAS, the demise of the Honolulu Symphony should not 14 mean the end to live symphonic music performances in Hawaii; 15 now, therefore, 16 17 18 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 19 20 of 2011, that the State Foundation on Culture and the Arts is requested to convene a task force to explore the creation of a 21 22 new, sustainable symphony in the wake of the liquidation of the Honolulu Symphony; and 23 24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force recommendations 25 are requested to include a plan to lay the foundation for a 26 sustainable symphony that serves the community and provides all 27 Hawaii students exposure to symphony performances; and 28 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the task force is requested to 30 include, but not be limited to the following members: 31 32
