REQUESTING THE INSTALLATION OF AUTOMATIC SPRINKLERS OR APPLICATION OF CERTIFIED FIRE-RETARDANT COATINGS IN NEWLY CONSTRUCTED ONE- AND TWO-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DWELLINGS TO BE REQUIRED UNDER THE STATE BUILDING CODE.

8	WHEREAS, fire sprinklers are a reliable method of	
9	protecting residents and homes from the dangers of fire; and

11	WHEREAS, although automatic fire sprinklers are a proven	
12	life-saving system, they are often expensive to install, even in	
13	new buildings; and

15	WHEREAS, certified fire-retardant coatings are currently	
16	available that comply with the standards provided in the	
17	International Fire Code; and

19	WHEREAS, these certified fire-retardant coatings provide	
20	the following	g benefits with respect to fire safety:

WHEREAS, these fire-retardant coatings typically cost, on 1 average, \$300 more than ordinary paint used for one- or two-2 family residential dwellings; and 3 4 WHEREAS, when these fire-retardant coatings are applied to 5 the interior of dwellings, they maintain their fire-retardant 6 qualities and effectiveness for many years without further 7 application; and 8 9 WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the residents of the 10 State of Hawaii for improvements in fire prevention to be 11 incorporated into the building permit process; now, therefore, 12 13 14 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 15 of 2011, that the State Building Code Council is requested to 16 adopt the requirement that automatic fire sprinklers be 17 installed or certified fire- retardant coatings be applied in 18 new one- and two-family residential dwellings constructed 19 throughout the State after January 1, 2012; and 20 21 22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Resolution be transmitted to the Comptroller, Chairperson of the 23 State Building Code Council, Chairperson of the State Fire 24 Council, and Fire Chief of each county. 25 26 27 28 OFFERED BY:
