HOUSE RESOLUTION

EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR REDUCING THE SURCHARGE IMPOSED ON THE COUNTIES FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE SURCHARGE ON THE GENERAL EXCISE TAX TO FUND MASS TRANSIT PROJECTS.

1 WHEREAS, funds for reducing Honolulu's traffic congestion problems must be obtained without increasing taxes; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the State retains a portion of revenues collected 4 under sections 46-16.8, 237-8.6, and 238-2.6, Hawaii Revised 5 6 Statutes, to offset collection and administration costs; and 7 WHEREAS, the State is now taking in more than it needs to 8 cover the costs of collecting the county surcharge on the 9 general excise tax for mass transit projects for the counties; 10 and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, the State surcharges the counties in the amount of 14 ten per cent of the amount that it collects for the counties, while the Department of Taxation has testified that it needs 15 only a three per cent surcharge to cover the costs of collecting 16 this tax; and 17 18 WHEREAS, a surcharge of five per cent by the State would 19 more than cover the costs incurred by the Department of Taxation 20 in collecting this county surcharge on the general excise tax 21 22 for the counties, as well as more than cover a possible increase in collection costs in the foreseeable future; and 23 24 WHEREAS, a reduction of the State's ten per cent surcharge 25 on the county surcharge on the general excise tax would result 26 in an increase in the amount of funds that a county would have 27 to apply to the rail system and, thereby, would contribute to 28

solving Honolulu's traffic congestion problems; now, therefore,
