## HOUSE RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO CREATE A NEW LANE ON LILIHA STREET BETWEEN KING STREET AND VINEYARD BOULEVARD.

WHEREAS, Liliha Street between King Street and Vineyard 1 2 Boulevard experiences an inordinate amount of traffic; and 3 4 WHEREAS, the residents that live in the area that use the 5 limited amount of street parking add to the congestion of Liliha Street between King Street and Vineyard Boulevard; and 6 7 WHEREAS, the ensuing gridlock adds to the frustration of 8 the residents of the area; and 9 10 WHEREAS, widening the stretch of Liliha Street between King 11 12 Street and Vineyard Boulevard would help alleviate the traffic 13 congestion by improving the flow of traffic through the area; 14 and 15 WHEREAS, widening the stretch of Liliha Street between King 16 Street and Vineyard Boulevard would help alleviate some of the 17 18 frustrations of the residents in the area; and 19 WHEREAS, widening the stretch of Liliha Street between King 20 21 Street and Vineyard Boulevard would also help and encourage economic growth through the expanding and fixing of vital 22 infrastructure; now, therefore, 23 24 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 25 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 26 of 2011, urges the Department of Transportation to create a new 27 lane on Liliha Street between King Street and Vineyard 28 29 Boulevard; and 30
