HOUSE RESOLUTION

HONORING AND COMMENDING THE UNITED STATES NAVY SEALS FOR SUCCESSFULLY NEUTRALIZING THE WORLD'S MOST WANTED TERRORIST.

WHEREAS, terrorism is defined as the systematic use of
 terror especially as a means of coercion, and is most often used
 against those who are unable to defend themselves resulting in
 countless deaths and numerous injuries; and

6 WHEREAS, on February 26, 1993 terrorists drove a truck into 7 the parking garage of the North Tower of the World Trade Center 8 detonating a bomb that took the lives of seven innocent people; 9 and

11 WHEREAS, on August 7, 1998 terrorists conducted a planned 12 assault on the US Embassies in Dar es Salaam, Tanzania, and 13 Nairobi, Kenya resulting in the deaths of over 200 local 14 nationals, and 12 US citizens; and

16 WHEREAS, adopted unanimously by the United Nations Security 17 Council on August 13, 1998, Resolution 1189 condemned the 18 terrorist attacks in Africa; and

20 WHEREAS, in retaliation for the assault on US Embassies in 21 Africa, the United States launched Operation Infinite Reach, a 22 coordinated cruise missile attack on terrorist bases in 23 Afghanistan which took place on August 20, 1998; and 24

25 WHEREAS, on October 12, 2000 terrorists attacked the USS 26 Cole while she was refueling in the port of Aden, Yemen 27 resulting in the deaths of 17 American sailors; and 28

29 WHEREAS, at 8:46 AM on September 11, 2001, American
30 Airlines Flight 11 slammed into the North Tower of the World

Trade Center instantly killing all 87 passengers and crew 1 aboard; and 2 3 4 WHEREAS, at 9:06 AM on September 11, 2001, United Airlines Flight 175 slammed into the South Tower of the World Trade 5 Center instantly killing all 60 passengers and crew aboard; and 6 7 8 WHEREAS, at 9:37 AM on September 11, 2001, American 9 Airlines Flight 77 crashed into the Pentagon, instantly killing 10 all those aboard, and taking the lives of 125 military personnel and Pentagon staff; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, at 10:03 AM on September 11, 2001, United Airlines Flight 93 crashed into a Pennsylvania field after passengers 14 15 heroically attempted to regain control of their hijacked 16 airplane; and 17 WHEREAS, the subsequent collapse of the North and South 18 Towers of the World Trade Center took the lives of almost 2,600 19 20 people, citizens of 90 countries, resulting in the largest death toll on American soil and larger than the attack on Pearl Harbor 21 22 and related military facilities on December 7, 1941; and 23 24 WHEREAS, the terrorist attacks on the United States of 25 September 11, 2001 resulted in the deaths almost 3,000 people, and thrust the United States into a new era of domestic security 26 27 recognizing that the risk of terrorist attacks on our soil and 28 elsewhere was very real; and 29 WHEREAS, on October 7, 2001, in response to the attacks of 30 31 September 11, 2001, armed forces of the United States along with her allies launched Operation Enduring Freedom in Afghanistan, 32 commencing the Global War on Terrorism in order neutralize the 33 Taliban and eliminate Al-Qaeda; and 34 35 WHEREAS, on October 12, 2002 terrorists bombed sites in 36 Bali, Indonesia killing 202 people making it the deadliest 37 attack in the history of Indonesia; and 38 39

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2003 terrorists conducted suicide 1 2 attacks in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia resulting in the loss of 35 3 lives; and 4 5 WHEREAS, on November 15, and November 23, 2003 terrorists 6 conducted suicide bombings in Istanbul, Turkey, killing 57, and 7 injuring hundreds; and 8 9 WHEREAS, on July 7, 2005 terrorists conducted suicide 10 attacks on the London Underground and public transportation 11 system resulting in the deaths of 52 people and injuring nearly 12 700 others; and 13 14 WHEREAS, the reality of the terrorist attacks referenced in the clauses above represent the global nature and scope of Al-15 16 Qaeda and their cognizant ability to indiscriminately murder 17 thousands of civilians worldwide; and 18 19 WHEREAS; these heinous attacks were conducted under the 20 guidance and leadership of the most senior leader of Al-Qaeda, 21 Osama bin Laden, the world's most wanted terrorist; and 22 23 WHEREAS, on April 29, 2011, in pursuit of supporting and 24 defending the Constitution of the United States against all 25 enemies, foreign and domestic, US Naval Special Warfare Operators, popularly referred to as Navy SEALs from the Naval 26 Special Warfare Development Group under the command of the Joint 27 Special Operations Command, successfully conducted a raid in 28 29 Abbottabad, Pakistan, neutralizing and eliminating the world's 30 most wanted terrorist; now, therefore, 31 32 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 33 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, honors and commends the United States Navy SEALs and 34 other special warfare operators for successfully neutralizing 35 36 the world's most wanted terrorist; and 37 38 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the House of Representatives mourns the victims of terrorist attacks worldwide, and honors 39 the sacrifices of all members of the armed forces of the United 40 41 States during the Global War on Terrorism; and
