## H.R. NO. 63

#### HOUSE RESOLUTION

ESTABLISHING POLICIES FOR THE LEGISLATIVE BROADCAST PROGRAM'S CABLECASTS AND WEBCASTS OF HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES' PROCEEDINGS.

WHEREAS, the legislative broadcast program was established 1 and began cablecasting the House of Representatives' proceedings 2 3 on a pilot basis in 1994, and has been renewed every session 4 since then; and 5 WHEREAS, Act 373, Session Laws of Hawaii 1997, codified as 6 7 chapter 21G, Hawaii Revised Statutes, relating to public access, established the legislative broadcast program; and 8 9 WHEREAS, the legislative broadcast program produces live 10 and tape-delayed video broadcasts of selected legislative 11 proceedings for cable casting on public, education and 12 13 government access channels and videocasting on the Internet; and 14 15 WHEREAS, the legislative broadcast program is intended to increase public access to, and participation in, the legislative 16 process; and 17 18 19 WHEREAS, 'Olelo Community Television continues to provide the Legislature with technical and engineering support, 20 programming time for cablecasts, broadcast production television 21 equipment, and preventive maintenance, repair, and replacement 22 as needed; and 23 24 WHEREAS, for the 2011 legislative session, the House of 25 26 Representatives will provide access to select legislative 27 proceedings via live and archived webcasts provided by 'Olelo Community Television; and 28



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1 WHEREAS, a private broadcast production company is 2 currently contracted by the Legislature to produce broadcasts of legislative proceedings; and 3 4 5 WHEREAS, to ensure consistency, reliability, and responsibility for programming, the House of Representatives 6 7 finds it necessary to establish policies to govern the 8 participation in the legislative broadcast program; now, 9 therefore, 10 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the 11 12 Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2011, that the following policies shall govern the activities 13 of the legislative broadcast program as they pertain to the 14 15 House of Representatives: 16 17 (1) Project Responsibility: The content, selection, and editorial policies shall be administered by the 18 Speaker of the House of Representatives or the 19 Speaker's designee. 'Olelo Community Television shall 20 provide technical and engineering support, programming 21 time for cablecasts, access to webcasts, broadcast 22 23 production television equipment, and preventive maintenance, repair, and replacement as needed; 24 25 (2) Distribution: Cablecast programming coverage and 26 27 distribution shall be provided by 'Olelo Community Television on O'ahu; by Akakū: Maui Community 28 Television on Maui, Moloka'i, and Lana'i; by Hō'ike 29 Kaua'i Community Television on Kaua'i; and by Na Leo 'O 30 Hawai'i, Inc., on Hawai'i. Webcast access shall be 31 provided by 'Olelo Community Television. All bona fide 32 news organizations and educational institutions may 33 34 use the programming material and shall bear costs associated with the programming. Campaign or 35 commercial uses of material distributed by the Speaker 36 of the House of Representatives, the Speaker's 37 designee, or the legislative contractor are 38 39 prohibited;



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- (3) Programming Content: Programming shall include live and tape-delayed cablecasts, and may include live and archived webcasts. All public committee hearings, legislative sessions, and other legislative proceedings shall be authorized for programming and selected by the Speaker of the House of Representatives or the Speaker's designee. In addition, the Speaker or the Speaker's designee may authorize special programming. Programming material distributed by the Speaker, Speaker's designee, or the legislative contractor shall not be used for campaign or commercial purposes;
- (4)Cablecasts and webcasts of legislative 14 Editing: proceedings shall be covered gavel-to-gavel, and shall 15 include coverage of the speaker recognized by the 16 17 chair or presiding officer. Occasional shots of the entire committee or assembled body shall be allowed; 18 however, close-up "reaction" shots shall not be 19 20 permitted; and
- (5) Ownership and Use of Programming: Tapes, cablecasts, 22 23 and webcasts shall be considered the property of the House of Representatives. Tapes, cablecasts, and 24 25 webcasts shall not be considered an official record of the meeting, and there shall be no liability for 26 27 inadvertent erasure or omission. Tapes of proceedings shall be retained for at least a period of time 28 necessary for rebroadcasts on neighbor island cable 29 systems, and for use in program evaluation and staff 30 training; 31
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- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
