WHEREAS the State of Hawaii and its residents are suffering 1 2 from a significant economic downturn; and 3 4 WHEREAS due to the current state of the economy there is a 5 dismal availability of affordable housing in the State; and 6 7 WHEREAS the foreclosures resulting from the housing 8 collapse have further contributed to the growing population of homelessness among working individuals; and 9 10 11 WHEREAS these individuals, while struggling to hold their lives together and keep their jobs, are faced with the 12 insecurity and dangers of sleeping in their vehicles on the 13 14 streets; and 15 WHEREAS the State has a vast inventory of parking spaces 16 that could easily be made available from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. for 17 the working homeless who reside in their vehicles; and 18 19 WHEREAS this will provide safety and access to services 20 greatly benefiting the working homeless; and 21 22 23 WHEREAS a myriad of other states, cities, churches, and other organizations in California, Oregon, and Texas, to name a 24 few, have already adopted this practice with great success in 25 helping these working individuals; and 26 27 28 WHEREAS the County of Kauai is now launching this program; now, therefore, 29
