## HOUSE RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, the Hawaii Revised Statutes are a cumulative 2 compilation of legislation enacted in the original legislative session convened in 1959, through the most recent legislative 3 session ending in 2010; and 4 5 WHEREAS, while each new session the legislature considers 6 7 repealing and amending out-of-date provisions of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, the focus must be on enacting and amending 8 9 provisions to respond to the current needs of the state, and 10 obsolete legislation often remains in the Hawaii Revised Statutes past its application or relevance; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, the legislature's resources are consumed by the 14 comprehensive duties of prospective lawmaking and responding to 15 the immediate concerns and needs of constituents; and 16 WHEREAS, obsolete legislation: 17 18 19 (1) Reduces the efficient and the streamlined application 20 of Hawaii law; 21 (2) May confuse the public and threaten confidence in the 22 23 legislature; and 24 25 (3) May conflict with newer laws; 26 now, therefore, 27 28 29 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Twenty-sixth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session 30
