BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 353B-6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "[+]§353B-6[+] Interstate transfer fee. The judiciary may
4 assess a fee not to exceed \$200 for each application made by a
5 parolee or probationer for a transfer out of the State; provided
6 that the fees collected shall be deposited into the [State's
7 general fund.] probation services special fund established in
8 section 706-649."

9 SECTION 2. Section 706-649, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by amending subsection (2) to read as follows:

11 "(2) Moneys in the probation services special fund shall
12 be used by the judiciary to [monitor,]:

13 (a) Monitor and enforce [, and collect fees, fines,

14restitution, other monetary obligations owed by15defendants, and other] compliance with the terms and16conditions of probation[-] and other supervision; and

17 (b) Support other duties and activities related to the

supervision of defendants."
