The following days of each 3 year are set apart and established as state holidays: 4 5 The first day in January, New Year's Day; 6 The third Monday in January, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., 7 Day; 8 The third Monday in February, Presidents' Day; 9 The twenty-sixth day in March, Prince Jonah Kuhio 10 Kalanianaole Day; 11 The Friday preceding Easter Sunday, Good Friday; 12 The last Monday in May, Memorial Day; The eleventh day in June, King Kamehameha I Day; 13 14 The fourth day in July, Independence Day; 15 The third Friday in August, Statehood Day; 16 The first Monday in September, Labor Day; 17 The eleventh day in November, Veterans' Day; The fourth Thursday in November, Thanksgiving Day; and 18 SB LRB 11-1129.doc
