4 <u>in state court</u>, shall not be excused by a court for <u>a</u> slight or
5 trivial cause, but only when it appears that jury duty would
6 entail a serious personal hardship[7] or that for other good
7 cause the prospective juror should be excused either temporarily
8 or otherwise."

10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
