BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 663-1.54, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Any person who owns or operates a business providing 4 recreational activities to the public, such as, without 5 limitation, scuba or skin diving, sky diving, bicycle tours, and 6 mountain climbing, shall exercise reasonable care to ensure the 7 safety of patrons and the public[7] and shall be liable for 8 damages resulting from negligent acts or omissions of the person 9 which cause injury."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 11 and stricken.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
