A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	PART I
2	INTRODUCTION
3	SECTION 1. The Legislature finds that section 89-10(b),
4	Hawaii Revised Statutes, states:
5	"(b) All cost items shall be subject to
6	appropriations by the appropriate legislative bodies.
7	The state legislature or the legislative bodies
8	of the counties acting in concert, as the case may be,
9	may approve or reject the cost items submitted to
10	them, as a whole. If the state legislature or the
11	legislative body of any county rejects any of the cost
12	items submitted to them, all cost items submitted
13	shall be returned to the parties for further
14	bargaining."
15	The legislature further finds that section 89-6, Hawaii
16	Revised Statutes, establishes thirteen bargaining units that are
17	authorized to bargain collectively in public employment. These
18	thirteen units are represented by six exclusive representative

1	organizat	ions, of which, five are authorized to negotiate with
2	the State	of Hawaii as the employer:
3	(1)	The United Public Workers, representing bargaining
4		units (1), nonsupervisory employees in blue-collar
5		positions; and (10), institutional, health, and
6		correctional workers;
7	(2)	The Hawaii Government Employees Association,
8		representing bargaining units (2), supervisory
9		employees in blue-collar positions; (3),
10		nonsupervisory employees in white-collar positions;
11		(4), supervisory employees in white-collar positions;
12		(6), educational officers and other personnel of the
13		department of education under the same pay schedule;
14		(8), personnel of the University of Hawaii and the
15		community college system, other than faculty; (9),
16		registered professional nurses; and (13), professional
17		and scientific employees, who cannot be included in
18		any of the other bargaining units;
19	(3)	The Hawaii State Teachers Association, representing
20		bargaining unit (5), teachers and other personnel of
21		the department of education under the same pay
22		schedule, including part-time employees working less

1		than twenty hours a week who are equal to one-half of	
2		a full-time equivalent;	
3	(4)	The University of Hawaii Professional Assembly,	
4		representing bargaining unit (7), faculty of the	
5	•	University of Hawaii and the community college system;

7	(5)	The Hawaii Fire Fighters Association, representing	
8		bargaining unit (11).	
9	The	purpose of this Act is to authorize cost items	
10	submitted to the legislature for bargaining units represented by		
11	the Hawaii State Teachers Association, and for officers and		
12	employees who are excluded from collective bargaining but belong		
13	to the same compensation plans as those officers and employees		
14	within corresponding bargaining units, which are applicable to		
15	fiscal years 2011-2012 and 2012-2013.

- 16 ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS
- 17 SECTION 6. Salary increases and cost adjustments provided
- 18 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is
- 19 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds
- 20 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be,
- 21 from the respective funds.

- 1 SECTION 7. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
- 2 that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2012, and
- 3 June 30, 2013, of the respective fiscal years, shall lapse as of
- 4 those dates.
- 5 SECTION 8. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 6 application thereof to any person or circumstances is held
- 7 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 8 applications of the Act which can be given effect without the
- 9 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 10 of this Act are severable.
- 11 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2030.
