7		mutilation, or poisoning of any pet animal or equine	
8		animal resulting in serious bodily injury or death of	
9		the pet animal or equine animal[-]; or	
10	<u>(b)</u>	Kills or attempts to kill any pet animal belonging to	
11		another person, without first obtaining legal	
12		authority or the consent of the pet animal's owner.	
13	(2)	Subsection $[\frac{(1)}{(1)}]$ $\underline{(1)(a)}$ shall not apply to:	
14	(a)	Accepted veterinary practices;	
15	(b)	Activities carried on for scientific research governed	
16		by standards of accepted educational or medicinal	
17		practices; or	
18	(c)	Cropping or docking as customarily practiced.
