BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Act 193, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, is
 amended by amending section 3 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 3. This Act shall apply to all terms of
4 imprisonment imposed [on] before or after the effective date of
5 this Act."

6 SECTION 2. The department of public safety, upon written 7 request by an inmate serving multiple terms of imprisonment, 8 shall recalculate the inmate's term of imprisonment to comply 9 with section 706-668.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended by 10 Act 193, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, and in compliance with the 11 retroactive effect of section 1 of this Act and, if warranted by 12 the recalculation, release the inmate.

13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;16 provided that section 1 shall take effect on January 1, 2012.

Report Title:

Hawaii Penal Code; Multiple Sentence of Imprisonment

Description:

Beginning 01/01/2012, retroactively requires that multiple terms of imprisonment run concurrently unless the court orders or the law mandates that the terms run consecutively. Effective immediately, directs department of public safety to recalculate the sentences of inmates who submit written requests and, if warranted by the recalculation, release the inmates.
