BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 486, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part V be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" §486- Fresh and previously frozen bread. (a) No bread
5	product shall be permitted to use the term "fresh" in its
6	labeling or advertising unless the product has been maintained
7	in an unfrozen state at all times.
8	(b) Bread products that are baked and then frozen before
9	sale shall be packaged with prominent labeling or printing that
10	reads "previously frozen". The type size of the print shall be
11	no less than a twenty-four point font."
12	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
