BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§328- Fresh baked goods; advertising. Baked goods
5	shall not be represented, advertised, labeled, or marketed using
6	the term "fresh" or "fresh bread" unless the baked goods have
7	never been frozen prior to retail sale to the consumer."
8	SECTION 2. Section 328-61, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9	amended to read as follows:
10	"§328-61 Notifying consumer. (a) No person shall sell or
11	offer to sell any uncooked thawed food which substantially
12	resembles the physical appearances of the fresh food without a
13	label, as hereinafter described, notifying the purchaser that
14	[such] <u>the</u> food had been frozen and then thawed out; provided
15	that this section shall not apply if the thawed foods are
16	processed by grinding or have been dehydrated before being
17	offered for retail sale.

1	(b) No grocer or wholesale club shall sell or offer to
2	sell any baked goods that have been previously frozen and are
3	being offered for sale in a thawed state, unless the grocer or
4	wholesale club posts a sign that:
5	(1) Identifies all of the baked good products sold in the
6	establishment that have been previously frozen;
7	(2) Is displayed within the establishment at the primary
8	location where the baked goods are sold; and
9	(3) Displays the words "previously frozen" in wording no
10	less than twenty-four point font and the names of the
11	products that were previously frozen in wording no
12	less than fourteen point font.
13	All suppliers of such products for resale in the State shall
14	provide their respective grocer or wholesale club with a listing
15	that identifies by name all previously frozen baked goods
16	provided by the supplier."
