1 sandwich-style bread, are processed by grinding or have been 2 dehydrated before being offered for retail sale." 3 SECTION 3. Section 328-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 4 amended to read as follows: 5 "§328-62 Description of label. "Label" means the 6 information required in this part to be placed on any food 7 products, including sliced, sandwich-style bread, by means of a 8 stamp, stencil, or printing by machine, or by attaching to the 9 immediate package, by sign, handbill, placard, or otherwise, the 10 words "PREVIOUSLY FROZEN" in letter size easily seen under 11 customary conditions of purchase [-]; provided that in the case 12 of previously frozen sliced, sandwich-style bread, the type size 13 of the lettering shall be no less than twenty-four point font." 14 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 16 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050. 17
