RELATING TO WELLNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 The legislature finds that the department of SECTION 1. health's healthy Hawaii initiative conducted a survey of Hawaii 2 3 employer-union health benefits trust fund members last year at the request of the outgoing trust fund management. The legislature is therefore interested in 2 authorizing and evaluating health and wellness alternatives that 3 reduce the incidence of chronic disease, support state employees 4 in adopting and maintaining healthier lifestyles, and reduce the 5 costs of health care expenditures associated with emergency care 6 and other hospital-based treatments for avoidable chronic 7 diseases. 8 The purpose of this Act is to establish a workplace 9 wellness pilot program. 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2011-2012 and 13 the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal 14 year 2012-2013 for the creation of a workplace wellness pilot 15 program. 16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 17 of health for the purposes of this Act. 18 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
