### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BOATING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 200, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
and to read as follows:

4 Operation of motorized vessels; persons "§200-5 authorized. (a) Any person operating a motorized vessel on the 6 waters of the State shall be required to possess a certificate of completion from a course on the safe use and operation of a 7 motor vessel. The course shall contain a component on Hawaii 8 9 waters and be approved by the National Association of State 10 Boating Law Administrators. Any person who is authorized by the 11 State to operate a thrill craft in a commercial thrill craft 12 zone and any person who possesses a valid license to operate a 13 vessel issued for maritime personnel by the United States Coast 14 Guard pursuant to 46 Code of Federal Regulations part 10 shall 15 be exempt from this section. 16 (b) No person shall operate a motorized vessel unless the 17 person is fifteen years of age or older, or is accompanied on-
