A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the concept of a 2 wilderness park in the culturally and historically rich south 3 Kona area on the island of Hawaii has been discussed for more 4 than thirty years. This area has significant archeological 5 sites that warrant protection and preservation. Act 59, Session 6 Laws of Hawaii 2003, established the south Kona wilderness area 7 and provided for the development of a comprehensive management 8 plan for the area; however, Act 59 was subsequently repealed on 9 December 31, 2007, by Act 215, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006.

10 The purpose of this Act is to establish a south Kona 11 wilderness area on the island of Hawaii, provide a mechanism for 12 the creation of a plan for management of the wilderness area, 13 and provide a framework for management of the wilderness area. 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 6E, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 15 by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and to read 16 as follows:

SECTION 3. In codifying the new sections added by section
2 of this Act, the revisor of statutes shall substitute
appropriate section numbers for the letters used in designating
the new sections in this Act.
SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
