A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TELECOMMUNICATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 199, Session Laws of Hawaii 2010, 2 established a broadband working group to develop procedures for 3 streamlining permitting functions that are applicable to the 4 development of broadband services and broadband technology. One 5 of the discussion items of the working group is to exempt from many of the permitting requirements the installation of new or 6 7 upgraded broadband infrastructure along existing conduits that are already used for telecommunications. 8

9 The purpose of this Act is to speed the deployment of high-10 speed broadband technology in Hawaii by exempting construction 11 of broadband infrastructure from certain permitting

12 requirements.

13 SECTION 2. From January 1, 2012, to January 1, 2017, 14 actions relating to the installation, improvement, construction, 15 or development of infrastructure relating to broadband service 16 or broadband technology, including the interconnection of 17 telecommunications cables, shall be exempt from county 18 permitting requirements and state permitting and approval 2011-1278 SB1161 SD1 SMA.doc

requirements, including but not limited to the requirements of 1 chapters 343, 171, and 205A, Hawaii Revised Statutes; provided 2 that the installation, improvement, construction, or development 3 of infrastructure shall: 4 5 Take place within existing rights-of-way or utility (1)easements or utilize existing telecommunications 6 7 infrastructure; and Make no significant changes to the existing rights-of-8 (2) 9 way, utility easements, or telecommunications infrastructure. 10 11 SECTION 3. No person or entity shall be required to upgrade or replace an existing utility pole when using that 12 13 utility pole to install new or improve existing telecommunications cables; provided that: 14 The overall weight load on the utility pole following 15 (1)the installation or improvement is not greater than 16 the weight load prior to the installation or 17 improvement; 18 The overall weight load on the utility pole does not (2) 19 exceed maximum utility pole safe weight capacities 20 established by the Federal Communications Commission; 21 22 and
