1 Section 209E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending the definition of "eligible business 3 activity" to read as follows: ""Eligible business activity" means the: 4 5 (1)Manufacture of tangible personal property, the wholesale sale of tangible personal property as 6 described in section 237-4, or a service business as 7 defined in this section; 8 9 (2)Production of agricultural products where the business is a producer as defined in section 237-5, or the 10 processing of agricultural products, all or some of 11 12 which were grown within an enterprise zone; Research, development, sale, or production of all 13 (3) 14 types of genetically-engineered medical, agricultural, 15 or maritime biotechnology products; or Production of electric power from wind or solar energy 16 (4)

for sale primarily to a public utility company for
