A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MANDATORY HEALTH COVERAGE FOR USE OF THE LIFEBED INTELLIGENT MEDICAL VIGILANCE SYSTEM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is the right of
- 2 all people in Hawaii to have access to health care in all its
- 3 facets, including use of the Lifebed Intelligent Medical
- 4 Vigilance System. The public relies heavily on health insurance
- 5 policies to provide adequate medical care. However, current
- 6 policies do not include coverage for use of the Lifebed
- 7 Intelligent Medical Vigilance System.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to require health insurance
- 9 policies in the State to provide coverage for use of the Lifebed
- 10 Intelligent Medical Vigilance System.
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 431:10A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 13 and to read as follows:
- 14 "S431:10A- Coverage for use of the Lifebed Intelligent
- 15 Medical Vigilance System. Notwithstanding any provision to the
- 16 contrary, each individual and group accident and health, or
- 17 sickness policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued or renewed

- 18 "\$432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
- 19 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
- 20 policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the State after
- 21 January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations pursuant to
- 22 this chapter, shall include benefits provided in sections

- 14 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011.
