A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the story of the
 100th Infantry Battalion/442nd Regimental Combat Team (RCT) is
 linked to Hawaii as well as the rest of United States. It is a
 story of Americans who went to war to prove their loyalty and to
 overcome prejudice, a story of honor and sacrifice. It is also
 a story in danger of being lost for generations to come.

7 The legislature further finds that a proposed Legacy Center 8 for the 100th/442nd RCT would promote the story of the 9 100th/442nd RCT and preserve a mounting collection of historical 10 material including photographs, letters, documents,

11 publications, artifacts, audio-visual material, and wartime 12 memorabilia. The Center would also serve as a focus for the 13 presentation of the archived materials as an educational 14 resource facility for students, teachers, researchers, authors, 15 and the general public.

16 The Center would include a library for study and research 17 and the housing of the veterans' oral history program;

and a visual exhibit space. In addition, the Center is
 envisioned as a gathering place where people can go in honor of
 those who served in the 110th/442nd.

4 The legislature further finds that the proposed location 5 for the Center is on the slopes of Diamond Head, adjacent to the 6 Kapiolani community college campus. Located at the corner of 7 Diamond Head road and Makapuu avenue, the property is owned by 8 the State of Hawaii, under the control and management of the 9 department of land and natural resources. The parcel is part of 10 tax map key: 3-1-042:020. The total area is seven acres, of 11 which approximately four acres was set aside in 1999 for use by 12 the University of Hawaii Kapiolani community college through Executive Order No. 3791. The balance of the parcel is 13 14 presently used by the State for storage and maintenance of 15 vehicles.

16 The purpose of this Act is to transfer 1.5 acres adjacent 17 to the approximately 3.993 acres set aside by Executive Order 18 No. 3791, to the University of Hawaii Kapiolani community 19 college, for a proposed Legacy Center for the 100th/442nd RCT. 20 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the 21 University of Hawaii Kapiolani community college shall have 22 jurisdiction and administrative authority over 1.5 acres 2011-0527 SB SMA.doc

adjacent to the approximately 3.993 acres previously set aside
 by Executive Order No. 3791, to the University of Hawaii
 Kapiolani community college, for a proposed Legacy Center for
 the 100th/442nd RCT.

5 SECTION 3. All appropriations, records, equipment,
6 machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents,
7 maps, and other personal property heretofore made, used,
8 acquired, or held by the department of land and natural
9 resources relating to the parcel of land transferred to the
10 University of Hawaii Kapiolani community college shall be
11 transferred with the lands to which they relate.

SECTION 4. The jurisdiction, functions, powers, duties, and authority exercised by the department of land and natural relating to the 1.5 acre land parcel shall be transferred to and conferred upon the University of Hawaii Kapiolani community college by this Act.

17 The University of Hawaii Kapiolani community college shall 18 succeed to all of the rights and powers previously exercised, 19 and all of the duties and obligations incurred, by the 20 department of land and natural resources in the exercise of the 21 functions, powers, duties, and authority transferred, whether

such functions, powers, duties, and authority are mentioned in
 or granted in any law, contract, or other document.

All rules, policies, procedures, guidelines, and other 3 4 material adopted or developed by the department of land and 5 natural resources to implement the provisions of the Hawaii Revised Statutes which are reenacted or made applicable to the 6 7 University of Hawaii Kapiolani community college by this Act, 8 shall remain in full force and effect until amended or repealed 9 by the University of Hawaii Kapiolani community college pursuant 10 to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes. In the interim, every reference to the department of land and natural resources or 11 12 chairperson of the board of land and natural resources in those 13 rules, policies, procedures, guidelines, and other material is 14 amended to refer to the University of Hawaii Kapiolani community 15 college or the chancellor of the University of Hawaii Kapiolani 16 community college, as appropriate.

All deeds, leases, contracts, loans, agreements, permits, or other documents executed or entered into by or on behalf of the department of land and natural resources pursuant to the provisions of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, which are reenacted or made applicable to the University of Hawaii Kapiolani community college by this Act, shall remain in full force and 2011-0527 SB SMA.doc

Every reference to the department of land and natural 2 resources or the chairperson of the board of land and natural 3 resources therein shall be construed as a reference to the 4 University of Hawaii Kapiolani community college or the 5 chancellor of the University of Hawaii Kapiolani community 6 college, as appropriate.

7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 8
