BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 103B-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows: 3 "(C) Every general contractor and every subcontractor 4 shall comply with this chapter for the entire duration of the 5 contract. Certification of compliance with this chapter shall be made under oath by an officer of the general contractor and 6 7 subscontractor to the procurement officer [on a monthly basis.] 8 with the notice of completion of the contract. 9 (d) A general contractor or subcontractor who fails to 10 comply with this chapter shall be subject to any of the 11 following sanctions: 12 Temporary suspension of work on the project until the (1)13 contractor or subcontractor complies with this 14 chapter; 15 (2)Withholding of payment on the contract or subcontract,

as applicable, until the contractor or subcontractorcomplies with this chapter;
