BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 103B-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:

4 "(a) A contractor awarded any contract shall ensure that
5 Hawaii residents compose not less than eighty per cent of the
6 workforce employed to perform the contract on a particular
7 construction project, as determined under subsection (b). Prior
8 to an award of a contract, the contractor may withdraw a bid if
9 the contractor finds that it is unable to comply with this
10 subsection."

11 2. By amending subsections (c) and (d) to read:

12 "(c) [Every general contractor and every subcontractor
13 shall comply with this chapter for the entire duration of the
14 contract.] Certification of compliance with this chapter shall
15 be made under oath by an officer of the general contractor and
16 applicable subcontractor to the procurement officer [on a
17 monthly basis.] with the notice of completion of the contract.

Construction Procurement Contracts; State Residents Employment

Description:

Requires the general contractor and applicable subcontractor for construction procurement under the Hawaii public procurement code to file certification of compliance with chapter 103B, HRS, with the notice of final completion of the contract. Provides that the general contractor shall not be sanctioned for noncompliance by a subcontractor. Allows general contractor to withdraw a bid prior to award of a contract if it finds it is unable to comply with eighty per cent Hawaii workforce requirement. (SD1)
