### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WAGES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 104, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 "§104-Prevailing wage enforcement special fund. (a) 5 There is created within the state treasury and to be 6 administered by the department, the prevailing wage enforcement 7 special fund, into which shall be transferred one tenth of one 8 per cent of the total amount of each contract subject to part I. 9 The prevailing wage enforcement special fund shall be (b) 10 used by the department solely for enforcing compliance with this 11 chapter, including increasing the number of department personnel 12 for inspections and investigations. 13 The one tenth of one per cent amount shall be (C) 14 calculated at the time a governmental contracting agency enters 15 into a contract with a contractor that is subject to this 16 chapter. The one tenth of one per cent amount shall be 17

calculated by the governmental contracting agency and
