PURPOSE:

To provide fund authorizations and appropriations for collective bargaining cost fund for fiscal biennium 2009-2011 the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund costs in the agreement negotiated with the exclusive bargaining representative of collective bargaining units 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 13 and their excluded counterparts beginning March 2011.

MEANS:

By the submittal of a specific appropriation measure.

JUSTIFICATION:

Funding emergency appropriations by the legislature are necessary to cover the cost of implementing the collective bargaining agreement recently negotiated between the State and the respective bargaining units representing State public officers and employees for Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust premium contributions for plan year 2010-2011.

Inasmuch as an agreement with the bargaining unit was not in time to include the cost items in the 2011-2013 biennium budget, a separate measure is proposed for submittal to the legislature.

Impact on the public: "(I)t is the public policy of the State to promote harmonious and cooperative relations between government and its employees and to protect the public by assuring effective and orderly operations of government. These policies are best effectuated by (1) recognizing the right of public employees to organize for the purpose of collective bargaining, (2) requiring the

public employers to negotiate with and enter into written agreements with exclusive representatives on matters of wages, hours, and other conditions of employment, while, at the same time, (3) maintaining merit principles and the principle of equal pay for equal work among state and county employees . . " (Section 89-1, HRS).
