[Unless] (a) For service before 4 July 1, 2011, unless a different meaning is plainly required by 5 context, as used in this part, "compensation" means normal periodic payments of money for service the right to which 6 7 accrues on a regular basis in proportion to the service 8 performed; overtime, differentials, and supplementary payments; 9 bonuses and lump sum salary supplements; and elective salary 10 reduction contributions under [sections] Sections 125, 403(b), 11 and 457(b) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. 12 Bonuses and lump sum salary supplements shall be deemed earned 13 when payable; provided that bonuses or lump sum salary 14 supplements in excess of one-twelfth of compensation for the 15 twelve months prior to the month in which the bonus or lump sum 16 salary supplement is payable, exclusive of overtime, bonuses, 17 and lump sum salary supplements, shall be deemed earned:
