A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Act 51, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, as amended 1 by Act 221, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, required the 2 3 implementation of a new allocation method, the weighted student formula, to distribute funds to schools based on the 4 5 characteristics of the students. Act 51, as amended, also created the committee on weights whose responsibility it is to 6 7 recommend a formula and various weights of characteristics to the board of education. With six years of experience, it has 8 9 become apparent that, to provide stability and predictability for the principals and the school community councils, an 10 11 improved practice would be to have the committee on weights meet 12 every odd-numbered year rather than each year. Schools that are 13 developing academic and financial plans to improve student achievement need to be assured of constant funding over a 14 15 two-year period.

16 The purpose of this Act is to require the committee on 17 weights to meet no less than once every odd-numbered year, 18 rather than every year.

Based upon 6 recommendations from the committee on weights, the board of 7 education, not less than [annually,] once every odd-numbered 8 year, shall adopt a weighted student formula for the allocation 9 of moneys to public schools that takes into account the 10 educational needs of each student. The department, upon the 11 receipt of appropriated moneys, shall use the weighted student 12 formula to allocate funds to public schools.
