## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BUDGET

#### **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for 2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of the Constitution of the state of Hawaii. 3 SECTION 2. The purpose of this Act is to amend Act 162, 4 Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, as amended by Act 180, Session Laws 5 of Hawaii 2010, to: 6 Appropriate additional general funds for the office of the 7 (1)governor (GOV 100) and the office of the lieutenant 8 9 governor (LTG 100) for fiscal year 2010-2011, to provide full-year staffing for the office of the governor and the 10 office of the lieutenant governor to properly exercise 11 12 statewide statutory and constitutional obligations of their 13 offices; (2) Appropriate additional general funds for the department of 14 business, economic development and tourism (BED 142) for 15 fiscal year 2010-2011, to provide funds and positions for 16 the deputy director and deputy director's secretary; 17 Provide general fund positions for the department of 18 (3)defense (DEF 110) for fiscal year 2010-2011, for the deputy 19

Except as otherwise provided, the 14 appropriation for the office of the lieutenant governor 15 (LTG 100) shall be expended at the discretion of the lieutenant governor; provided further that for fiscal year 2010-2011, the 16 outgoing administration shall not expend or encumber more than 17 18 \$300,508 and the incoming administration shall not expend or encumber more than [\$120,509] \$421,591 of the general fund 19 20 appropriation."

21 SECTION 8. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 22 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 23

PURPOSE:

To 1) appropriate funds and positions in fiscal year 2010-2011 to enable staffing of the Offices of the Governor and the Lieutenant Governor from January 2011 through June 2011; and 2) appropriate positions and funds for Deputy and/or Deputy's secretary for specified positions.

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE BUDGET.

Authorize emergency appropriations of general funds effective fiscal year 2010-2011 for expenditure by the Office of the Governor, the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism, Department of Defense, and the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations.

JUSTIFICATION:

The 2009 and 2010 Regular Sessions of the Legislature deleted the Administration's funding request for full-year staffing of the Office of the Governor in fiscal year 2010-2011. Funding authorized by the Legislature by Act 162, SLH 2009, as amended by Act 180, SLH 2010, deleted requested funding for the last two quarters of fiscal year 2010-2011, effectively omitting gubernatorial staffing from January through June 2011. Funding was also deleted for certain positions and operating expenses for the Office of the Lieutenant Governor, Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism, Department of Defense, and the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations.

Impact on the public: The requested funding is necessary to enable the Governor and the Lieutenant Governor, as highest officers of the Executive Branch, to properly exercise

statewide statutory and constitutional obligations of their offices. Without the means to engage appropriate staff support, the Governor and Lieutenant Governor cannot be expected to manage and ensure the proper implementation of State programs and services provided to the public. The reality of three separate but co-equal branches of government will be thereby thwarted and indirectly undermined, unless reasonable capabilities are provided to the executive as well. The Deputy Director positions and Deputy Director's secretary positions are critical to enable departments to properly operate and manage their respective department's programs and functions.

Impact on the department and other agencies: This request for funding seeks to reestablish the appropriate balance between the branches of government by providing sufficient resources to the Governor. This will enable the Governor to properly exercise that office's responsibilities for management of all Executive departments and agencies. The requested funding will also provide necessary resources to support general operations of the Office of the Lieutenant Governor in the capacity as Secretary of State, Department of Business, Economic Development and Tourism, Department of Defense, and the Department of Labor and Industrial Relations.

Other impacts: The general fund recommendation included in this measure has been made in accordance with the statutorily defined appropriation ceiling for the Executive Branch pursuant to Section 37-92, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
