## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR SPECIAL FUND.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended 2 by adding a new section to part III to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 Lieutenant governor; fees. The lieutenant 5 governor shall charge the following fees that shall be deposited 6 into the general fund: 7 (1) For signing an apostille or certification, \$10; 8 For preparing every photostat copy of any document on (2) 9 record in the lieutenant governor's office, 50 cents **10** per page or portion thereof; and 11 For all other acts and duties, the fees for which are (3) 12 not otherwise provided, such charges as the lieutenant 13 governor may from time to time prescribe."
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 26-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) Except as otherwise provided by law, the lieutenant 16
- 17 governor is designated the secretary of state for

- 1 intergovernmental relations and shall perform the duties and
- 2 functions heretofore exercised by the secretary of Hawaii. The
- 3 duties and functions shall include, but not be limited to,
- 4 recordation of all legislative and gubernatorial acts,
- 5 [certification] apostilles and other certifications of state
- 6 documents, and maintenance of an official file of rules adopted
- 7 by state departments as provided in chapter 91. The lieutenant
- 8 governor may employ staff as necessary without regard to chapter
- 9 76."
- 10 SECTION 3. Section 91-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 11 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, each agency
- 13 may charge up to a maximum fee of ten cents per page, plus the
- 14 actual costs of mailing, for the reproduction of paper copies of
- 15 the following:
- 16 (1) Proposed and final rules, whether new rules, amended
- 17 rules, or repealed rules, in any format; and
- 18 (2) Notices of proposed rulemaking actions pursuant to
- 19 section 91-3(a)(1).
- 20 This section shall not apply to the reproduction by the office
- 21 of the lieutenant governor of other agencies' rules, kept in the
- 22 general collection of the office of the lieutenant governor.

Charges for the reproduction of paper copies of rules in the 1 2 general collection of the office of the lieutenant governor 3 shall be as stated in section [92-21.] 92- ." SECTION 4. The auditor shall examine whether a special 5 fund established in the office of the lieutenant governor for 6 the deposit of the fees established in section 1 of this Act and 7 section 574-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, would adequately fund 8 the costs for the administration and operation of the lieutenant 9 governor's functions under sections 26-1(a) and 574-5, Hawaii 10 Revised Statutes. The examination shall include an: 11 Analysis using the criteria relating to proposed 12 special funds under section 23-11, Hawaii Revised 13 Statutes; Estimate, on an annual basis, of the projected costs 14 (2) 15 for the lieutenant governor's functions under sections 16 26-1(a) and 574-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the projected revenues from the fees established in **17** 18 section 1 of this Act and section 574-5, Hawaii 19 Revised Statutes; and 20 <sub>E</sub> (3) Evaluation of whether the estimated costs and fee 21 revenues described in paragraph (2) indicate that

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general funds would be needed to supplement the 1 2 special fund. The auditor shall report its findings and recommendations, 3 4 including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later 5 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2012. 6 7 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 8 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2011. 9
