# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RENTAL MOTOR VEHICLE SURCHARGE TAX.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to maintain a rental
 motor vehicle surcharge tax of \$3 a day.

3 SECTION 2. Section 251-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

5 "(a) There is levied and shall be assessed and collected 6 each month a rental motor vehicle surcharge tax of [\$2 a day, 7 except that for the period of September 1, 1999, to August 31, 8 2011, the tax shall be] \$3 a day, or any portion of a day that a 9 rental motor vehicle is rented or leased. The rental motor 10 vehicle surcharge tax shall be levied upon the lessor; provided 11 that the tax shall not be levied on the lessor if:

12 (1) The lessor is renting the vehicle to replace a vehicle
13 of the lessee that is being repaired; and
14 (2) A record of the repair order for the vehicle is
15 retained either by the lessor for two years for
16 verification purposes or by a motor vehicle repair
17 dealer for two years as provided in section 437B-16."

1	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the state highway
2	fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary
