## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 3 and to read as follows:
- ""Aftermarket motorcycle frame" means a frame that is 5 manufactured to replace the frame of a motorcycle that was 6 certified by its manufacturer to be in compliance with all
- 7 applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards as of the date
- 8 of manufacture, or the frame of a homemade motorcycle that was
- 9 manufactured not for profit by a person who built the motorcycle
- 10 as a hobby."

- 11 SECTION 2. Section 286-42, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 12 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- "(a) The county director of finance shall examine and to 13
- 14 the best of the director's ability determine the genuineness and
- 15 regularity of every registration and transfer of registration of
- 16 a vehicle [as in] pursuant to this part [provided, in order] to
- 17 ensure that every certificate issued for a vehicle [shall

1 the vehicle and to prevent the registration of a vehicle by any 2 person not entitled [thereto, and the] to the vehicle. The 3 director of finance may require any applicant to furnish [such] 4 information, in addition to that contained in the application, [as may be] that is necessary to satisfy the director of finance 5 6 of the truth and regularity of the application. The director of 7 finance may accept any county certificate of title issued for a 8 vehicle as prima facie evidence of ownership for registration 9 and transfer of registration. The director may issue vehicle **10** identification numbers for reconstructed vehicles, special 11 interest vehicles, or motorcycles[ , which ] that do not have 12 vehicle identification numbers if the director determines that **13** the requirements of this section have been met. 14 The county director of finance may register a motorcycle 15 with an [after market] aftermarket motorcycle frame, using the [vehicle identification] number of the frame as issued by the 16 **17** [incomplete vehicle] manufacturer of the frame[-], the vehicle 18 identification number on the certification label, or a vehicle 19 identification number assigned by the director of finance. A 20 bill of sale and [Manufacturers] Manufacturer's Statement of Origin for the frame, engine, and transmission must be presented 21 22 and retained as a part of the permanent county registration



- 1 records. If a [Manufacturers] Manufacturer's Statement of
- 2 Origin is not available for the engine and transmission due to
- 3 the use of a used or reconstructed engine, transmission, or
- 4 both, then a bill of sale or other proof of ownership,
- 5 satisfactory to the director of finance must be presented.
- 6 Except for motorcycles that are built on an aftermarket
- 7 motorcycle frame, special interest vehicles, and reconstructed
- 8 vehicles, any motor vehicle or device that is not certified by
- 9 the manufacturer to be in compliance with all applicable Federal
- 10 Motor Vehicle Safety Standards as of the date of manufacturer
- shall not be registered."
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

## Report Title:

Motor Vehicle Registration

## Description:

Defines "aftermarket motorcycle frame" and allows the county director of finance to assign a vehicle identification number to a motorcycle with an aftermarket frame. Except for special interest vehicles, reconstructed vehicles, and motorcycles with an after market frame, disallows the registration of uncertified motor vehicles and devices. (SB1325 HD1)
