## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT MANOA.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 304A-2264, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

"[+]§304A-2264[+] Conference center revolving fund; 3 University of Hawaii at Manoa. There is established the 4 conference center revolving fund for the conference center 5 6 program in the [college of continuing education and community service of the] University of Hawaii at Manoa. All fees, 7 8 charges, and other moneys collected in conjunction with the conference center program shall be deposited in the revolving 9 10 fund. The [dean of the college of continuing education and community service] chancellor of the University of Hawaii at 11 Manoa or the chancellor's designee is authorized to expend funds 12 13 from the revolving fund for all costs associated with conducting 14 conferences, seminars, and courses by the conference center program, including but not limited to expenses for fees for 15 16 service rendered, honoraria, hotel and room rentals, food and 17 refreshment, printing and mailing, airfare and per diem, leis,

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII AT MANOA.

PURPOSE: To reflect the change in authority of the conference center program (hereinafter referred as "Program") as well as language to provide maximize flexibility for the operation of the Program and the needs of the conference hosts.

MEANS: Amend section 304A-2264, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: The University of Hawaii at Manoa went through an extensive programs review as part of the UH Manoa Budget Workgroup, to better align programs to maximize flexibility and enhance revenue-generating capabilities. One of the recommendations of the committee was to move the Program from the College of Continuing Education and Community Service to Auxiliary and Commercial Enterprises. The modifications to section 304A-2264, Hawaii Revised Statutes, reflects the change in authority of the Program as well as language to maximize flexibility for the operation of the Program and the needs of the conference hosts. The new language enables the Conference Center to meet its customer's requirements for quick and customized contracting and purchasing. It is a service that ensures that the Center can provide its customers with quality conferences, seminars and courses.
