## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING FOR THE DISABLED.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 291-54, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§291-54 Display of removable and temporary removable 4 windshield placards. The placard shall be displayed in such a 5 manner that it may be viewed from the front and rear of the 6 vehicle by hanging it from the front windshield rearview mirror 7 of a vehicle [utilizing-a parking space reserved for persons 8 with disabilities. When there is no rearview mirror, when in 9 use. If the design of the rearview mirror precludes hanging the 10 placard in a secure manner, the placard shall be displayed on 11 the dashboard."

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketedand stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
