# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 "§269- Electronic documents. (a) No later than January 5 1, 2012, the commission shall accept any filing or application 6 submitted pursuant to this chapter as either a conventional 7 paper document or an electronic document. If a signature is 8 required on any filing or application submitted electronically, 9 that requirement shall be satisfied for an electronic document by the inclusion of an electronic signature. Chapter 489E shall 10 11 apply to all electronic documents submitted pursuant to this 12 section. 13 (b) For the purposes of this section, acceptable means of 14 submitting electronic documents shall be: 15 (1) Completion of an Internet-based form provided by the 16 commission on the commission's website;
