RELATING TO COMMUNITY CARE FOSTER FAMILY HOMES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 346D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§346D-</u> Community-based facility; commensurate medicaid
5	reimbursement. For the purpose of reimbursement, all medicaid
6	beneficiaries categorized in the same or equivalent level of
7	care, living in a community-based facility, whether a licensed
8	community care foster family home or licensed adult residential
9	care home and for reason of reimbursement parity, shall receive
10	a commensurate amount of reimbursement for board and lodging and
11	food and services."
12	SECTION 2. Section 346-331, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
13	amended by amending the definition of "community care foster
14	family home" to read as follows:
15	""Community care foster family home" or "home" means a home

14	amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:

16	subject to monitoring and evaluation by the department or its
17	designee for certification compliance and quality assurance on
18	an annual or biennial basis. In complying with this subsection,
19	any community care foster family home shall ensure the following
20	are current and made available for inspection by the department
21	and clients:

Report Title: Community Care Foster Family Homes

Description:

Requires Community Care Foster Family Homes to have a primary caregiver as a certified nurse aide and a substitute caregiver as a nurse aide with a certain minimum number of continuing education hours; be certified and in operation for a year prior to being certified for a third client; and make various certifications and licenses available for inspection. Requires reimbursements for reason of parity of Medicaid beneficiaries in the same level of care in a community-based facility. Effective July 1, 2050. (SB1360 HD1)
