## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMUNITY CARE FOSTER FAMILY HOMES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 346-331, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended b	y amending the definition of "community care foster	
3	family hos	me" to read as follows:	
4	" "Coi	mmunity care foster family home" or "home" means a home	
5	that, for	the purposes of this part:	
6	(1)	Is regulated by the department in accordance with	
7		rules that are equitable in relation to rules that	
8		govern expanded adult residential care homes;	
9	(2)	Is issued a certificate of approval by the department	
10		or its designee to provide, for a fee, twenty-four-	
11		hour living accommodations, including personal care	
12		and homemaker services, for not more than two adults	
13		at any one time, at least one of whom shall be a	
14		medicaid recipient, who are at the nursing facility	
15		level of care, who are unrelated to the foster family,	
16		and who are receiving the services of a licensed home	
17		and community-based case management agency; provided	
18		that the department, in its discretion, may certify a	
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1 home for a third adult who is at the nursing facility 2 level of care and a medicaid recipient; provided that 3 [<del>the</del>]: 4 The home has been certified and in operation for (A) 5 not less than one year; and The primary [and substitute caregivers are 6 (B) 7 certified nurse aides who have ] caregiver is a 8 certified nurse aide as defined in section 457A-9 1.5 who has completed a state-approved training 10 program and other training as required by the 11 department[+], including a minimum of twenty-four 12 hours of continuing education every two years, in 13 addition to the requirements of section 346-46, 14 and the substitute caregiver is a nurse aide as 15 defined in section 457A-1.5, who has completed a 16 minimum of sixteen hours of continuing education 17 <u>every</u> two years; 18 and 19 Does not include expanded adult residential care homes (3) 20 or assisted living facilities, which shall continue to

be licensed by the department of health."

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1	SECTION 2. Section 346-334, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by amending subsection (g) to read as follows:	
3	"(g) Any community care foster family home shall be	
4	subject to monitoring and evaluation by the department or its	
5	designee for certification compliance and quality assurance on	
6	an annual or biennial basis. In complying with this subsection,	
7	any community care foster family home shall ensure that the	
8	following are current and made available for inspection by the	
9	department and clients:	
10	(1) A certificate of approval;	
11	(2) Licenses for case managers as required in the	
12	department's administrative rules, and a list of case	
13	managers' names;	
14	(3) Certifications for certified nurse aides pursuant to	
15	section 457A-7; and	
16	(4) Certifications for nurse aides if applicable."	
17	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed	
18	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.	
19	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.	

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**Report Title:** Community Care Foster Family Homes

#### Description:

Requires Community Care Foster Family Homes to have a primary caregiver as a certified nurse aide and a substitute caregiver as a nurse aide with a certain minimum number of continuing education hours for Community Care Foster Family Homes certified for a maximum of three clients; be certified and in operation for a year prior to being certified for a third client; and make various certifications and licenses available for inspection. Effective July 1, 2050. (SB1360 HD2)
